About the Webinar- The New Education Policy 2020 is the first education policy of the 21st century which aims to focus all the growing developmental imperatives of India. This policy proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education sectors, covering its regulation and governance, to create a new system that is align with the aspirational goals of 21st century education. The NEP 2020 lays particular emphasis on the development of the creative potential of each individual. It is based on the principle that education must develop not only cognitive capacities both the foundational capacity of literacy and numeracy and higher order cognitive capacities such as critical thinking and problem solving—but also social, ethical and emotional capacities and depositions. The elements incorporated taking into account the local and needs of the country and with a respect for and deference to its rich diversity and potentials.

There are huge developmental disconnects between the rural and urban sectors such as inequity in health, education, incomes, basic amenities etc., all causing great disconnect and large –scale migration to urban areas. So far, our professional higher educational institutions have largely been oriented to cater to the mainstream industrial sector have hardly contributed directly to the development of the rural sectors Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) is a much needed and highly challenging in this regard. It is necessary to promote development of rural areas in tune with Gandhian ideology of self-sufficient village republic, based on local resources and using decentralised, eco-friendly technologies so that the basic needs of food, cloth, shelter, health, livelihood, education etc. are locally met.

With an idea to analyse these areas and with the advice of the National Coordinator UBA New Delhi, UBA Unit Ideal Girls' College Akampat is organizing a national Webinar on *New Education Policy 2020 and Rural Development* on 22nd September 2020.
