Principal Ideal Girls' College, Akampat, Imphal East. Ideal Girls' College, Akampat is the only girls' college in the Imphal East District of Manipur, established on 6th December 1970. The college is affiliated to Manipur University, Canchipur and recognized by the University Grants Commission under Section 2f & 12b of the UGC Act 1956. Ideal Girls' College occupies a total land area of 7.5 acre at Akampat, Singjamei-Kongba Road, which can accommodate the necessary infrastructure of curricular and extra-curricular activities of girl students and exposed their talents and skill activities. Noteworthy features of the college are its well qualified faculties, enough infrastructure, vocational courses, new pedagogical basic Languages & IT course etc, apart from the conventional degree programme in Arts & Sciences.

Administration:

As a head of the institution, the College Principal is responsible for the administration of the college under the guidelines and directives of the higher authority. In carrying out the administration, the Principal is assisted by various committees and cells like the Admission Committee, Examination Committee, Board of Studies & Academic Committee etc consisting of the teaching and non teaching faculties of the college. Stakeholders, like Students' Union, Parents Association, local bodies etc are also invited and involved from time to time whenever situation demands.

Library:

The College Library is well equipped with text books, reference books and encyclopedias. Both teachers and student have accessed to the rich collections of books in the reading room of the Library. The Library cards are issued to the bonafide students and faculty members of college to borrow the books from the library.

GYM Club:

The college runs a Gym Club for students. It has all the equipments required to maintain good physique and health. The college has produced many eminent sportspersons of national and international repute. The students of the college earned several prizes in the inter college sports competitions organized by Manipur University and got selection for participation in zonal and interuniversity competitions. Beside these Aerobic and Yoga classes is practice in both teachers and students from time to time.

College Auditorium:

The college has well maintained two Auditoriums where seminars, the college functions, indoor games and, meetings are organized regularly. Above these two, the college has two medium size conference halls for organizing literary and academic programmes.

Women's Hostel:

The college has a well furnished hostel which could provide accommodation to 40 inmates. Students who are residing far from the college can avail of this facility. The functioning of the Hostel is looked after by a Hostel Management Committee, formed by the teaching faculties of the college. Warden of the hostel looks after and take decision for enforcement of all the rules and regulations of the hostel.

Remedial & Tutorial Coaching Class:

All the departments are conducting extra tutorial classes with the needs of the students. Teacher Mentees are taking extra care for course analysis with their Mentor Students. It is proposed to organize Remedial Coaching Classes especially for the S.C/ST/O.B.C. and M.O.B.C. students free of cost. Whatsapp groups are formed separately for all the departments and extra classes are conducted when there is problem in interface between the teacher and students.

NSS:

The college also gets actively involved in extension activities like providing NSS to the students. NSS volunteers of the college conducted cleanliness drive inside and outside the college campus, organized sensitization programme on Single Use Plastic with neighboring community, hotels and shops etc. A teacher assigned as Programme Officer looks after NSS activities.

Meritorious Cash Awards:

- **1.** <u>P. Randhoni Devi Memorial Cash Award</u> is instituted by the teachers association of the college in memory of late P. Randhoni Devi, founder and Head, Department of Education of the college. The Award consists of a nominal cash award and a citation to the students of the college who secured highest total marks in the Degree of Bachelor of Arts and Degree of Bachelor of Science Examinations respectively conducted by Manipur University, Canchipur.
- 2. <u>Foundation Day Special Cash Award</u> is given to those students who secured positions in the Degree of Bachelor of Arts and Science Examinations respectively conducted by Manipur University, Canchipur.
- **3.** <u>RK. Munindro Singh Memorial Award for Excellence</u> is instituted by RK. Gourisana Devi, a former Principal and Head, Department of Mathematics, Ideal Girls' College, Akampat in the name of her late father RK. Munindro Singh of

Brahmapur Mange Makhong, Imphal East to promote a sense of competition and to recognise the achievements made by the students of the college in curricular and extracurricular activities during their course of studies in the college. The award carries an amount of Rupees 3000.00 (rupees three thousand) only with a citation. The awardees shall be selected from amongst the students of the college who excelled both in academic and extracurricular activities in an academic year.

4. <u>Thoudam Ibohal Singh Cash Award</u>, donated by Dr. Th. Tilakraj Singh, Assistant Professor in Botany Department of the College, is given every year to a student for securing highest mark in Botany subject in the Degree of Bachelor of Science Examination, conducted by Manipur University, Canchipur.

COURSES OFFERED & INTAKE CAPACITY

The Manipur University introduced Semester system for the Three Year Degree from the academic session 2010-11 onwards. Students shall have to opt one subject as an Honours paper from Fifth Semester onwards.

I. Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.)

It is a Three Years Degree Course comprising of six semesters. study leading to the Bachelor of Science Degree. A student should opt for Honours Course in the Semester V and VI (3rd year) in one of the following subjects - Botany, Chemistry, Home science. The table below shows the subject combinations offered, subjects to be passed in 10+2 (Science) or equivalent examination recognised by board, council, Manipur University. Eligibility Criteria for B.Sc.

Girl students, who opted Science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Botany) and secured minimum of 55% marks in aggregate in 10+2 or equivalent examination of any Board or Council, recognized by Manipur University.

2. Bachelor of Arts (B.A.)

There shall be a Three year Degree Course of study leading to the Bachelor of Arts' Degree. A student should opt for Honours Course only in the semesters V and VI (3rd year) in any one of the following subjects - English, Manipuri, Political Science, Education, Home Science, Geography, History. The subject combination allowed, intake capacities are given in table below.

Eligibility Criteria for B.A.

Securing minimum of 45% marks in aggregate in 10+2 or equivalent examination of any Board or Council, recognized by Manipur University.

Selection Procedures:

- Selection will be held purely on the basis of comparative merit list.
- Government Reservation policy will be followed in toto.
- Students belonging to OBC/SC/ST will get relaxation in minimum cut-off marks up to the extent of 2%, 3%, 5% respectively.
- Reserved seats will be allotted within every subject combination or group
- If a selected candidate does not take admission within the specified/stipulated period of time, he/she will lose the seat. No further consideration will be given.
- Physically challenged or sports persons of eminence, national/international players of the repute will be given direct admission on production of certificates of excellence.
- In case of any discrepancy/dispute arising, the decision of the Admission Committee will be final.

Important Information for Candidates

- 1. Incomplete application forms will be rejected.
- 2. Candidates are required to produce the original mark sheets at the time of admission.
- 4. If any error/omission in the processing/verification of certificates/documents of a candidate is detected after admission to a course, the College Authority has the right to cancel such admission at any stage at which the error is detected.
- 5. The seats of the candidates who have failed to report for admission within the stipulated time shall be forfeited and the same seats shall be offered to other candidates next in order of merit. No further correspondence in this regard shall be entertained.
- 6. Documents once submitted along with the application form shall not be returned.
- 7. Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from other Board/Council other than the Council of Higher Secondary Education, Manipur shall have to submit the MIGRATION CERTIFICATE at the time of admission or within one month from the date of admission.

- Original documents of all the attested copies enclosed at the time of form submission should be produced at the time of final admission.
- The college will accept self-attested copies of documents/papers provided by students. In case of any false attestation/falsified records being detected at any point of time, either the student will be debarred from admission or his/her admission will be cancelled at once and in addition.

Subjects to be Offered and Examination Scheme

There shall be 6 Semesters (Semester I to VI) during the three year degree course. In semester I and II, a student has to offer MIL * or General English and 3 Elective Papers (As shown in Table 1 and Table 2). Each paper will carry 100 marks and shall be evaluated at the end of the Semester Examination. The examination of a paper will be three hours duration. For an Elective Paper comprising of Theory and Practical components; theory shall be of 75 marks and 25 marks for Practical. The pattern for Semester III and IV shall be as per University Ordinance.

Honours courses shall have to be offered only in Semester V and VI. The Honours Subject should be one of the Elective Subjects offered in the previous Semester. A student shall have to offer only one. An Honours subject has three papers of 100 marks each in a Semester. The pattern for semester V and VI shall be as per University Ordinance.
