

REPORT
OF
A TWO-DAY INTERNATIONAL E-CONFERENCE ON
“SUBALTERN & SUBDUED VOICES IN LITERATURE AND
SOCIETY”

from 21st – 22nd February, 2022

A Two-Day International e-Conference on “Subaltern & Subdued Voices in Literature and Society” was successfully organized by the Department of English under the aegis of the IQAC, Ideal Girls’ College, Akampat, Imphal East from the 21st to 22nd February, 2022, with Khundrakpam Nirupama, Assistant Professor, Department of English as the Convenor, Dr. Sarita Khumallambam, Head, and P.K. Alphinah, Assistant Professor, Department of English as the Co-Convenors of the event. Shri L. Iboyaima Singh, Principal in-charge, Ideal Girls’ College presided the Inaugural cum Plenary Session as the President and Chief Patron. Dr. Rangitabali Waikhom, IAS, Director, University & Higher Education, Govt. of Manipur inaugurated the conference from the college premises. Khundrakpam Nirupama, convenor of the conference and Dr. Ph. Linthoingambi, Member of Organising Committee and IQAC, Ideal Girls’ College delivered the Welcome Address and the Vote of Thanks respectively.

Dr. Chungkham Sheelaramani, Principal, DM College of Arts, DM University and Dr. Angomcha Bimol Akoijam, Associate Professor, Centre for the Study of Social Systems, JNU, Delhi delivered talks based on the theme of the conference as Keynote Speakers. The Inaugural cum Plenary Session continued for three and half hours (9am to 12.30noon) on Google Meet. The speakers were given an hour each for presentations and Q & A session.

P.K. Alphinah, Co-Convenor of the event hosted the Inaugural cum Plenary Session.

There were five technical sessions (Parallel Sessions).

Technical Session I titled as “**Reading the Narrative of the Indigenous**” chaired by Dr. Deepak Naorem, Assistant Professor, Daulat Ram College, DU continued for two and half hours (1pm to 3.30pm) with 10 paper presenters in total. Karuna Sagolshem, B.Sc. 2nd Semester Student of the college served as the rapporteur of this session. Khundrakpam Nirupama, Convenor, hosted the Session I.

Technical Session II titled as “**Gender Rights & Literature**” chaired by Maisnam Arnopal, Chancellor’s Doctoral Fellow, University of California, Santa Barbara with Remishree Yumlembam, B.A. 4th Semester Student of this college as the rapporteur of the session continued for two and half hours (11am to 1.30pm). There were 9 paper presenters in total. P.K. Alphinah, Co-Convenor hosted the Session II.

Dr. Bimol Akoijam, Associate Professor, JNU chaired the Technical Session III entitled “**The Social Condition of the Marginalized**” with Prof. Faisal Ahmmed, Shahjalal University of Science and Technology, Bangladesh and Kayenpaibam Monica Devi, B.A. H.Sc. Hons. 6th Semester, Student of this College as Featured Speaker and rapporteur respectively. The session continued for two and half hours (11am to 1.30pm) with 10 paper presenters in total. Dr. Sarita Khumallambam, Co-Convenor and Dr. E. Jenita, Member of Organizing Committee co-hosted the Session III.

Dr. Michael Stadler, DAAD-Lektor, Germany (Exchange Faculty, Centre for German Studies, JNU) served as the Chairperson, Dr. Piyaboot Sumettikoon, Lecturer, Chiang Mai

University, Thailand as the Featured Speaker and Maisnam Keniya Chanu, B.A. 4th Semester, Student of this college as the rapporteur respectively of Technical Session IV entitled “Representation of the ‘Other’ in Media, Culture, Literature & Politics”. This was an afternoon session which continued for two and half hours (1.30pm to 4pm) with 7 paper presenters. Dr. Ph. Linthoingambi, Member of Organizing Committee hosted the Session IV.

A parallel session to session IV, Technical Session V entitled “**Manipuri Sahitya Amadi Samaj da Namthabiraba Khonjelsingi Mapham**” was chaired by Dr. Chirom Rajketan Singh, Associate Professor, Dept. of Manipuri, Manipur University with Prof. Toijam Tampha, Head, Dept. of Manipuri, Manipur University as the Featured Speaker and Th. A total of 98 individuals from different disciplines including engineering branch, commerce and science registered and participated in the said conference from within India and abroad. 55 Research Scholars and Faculty presented papers from across India.
